PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAMME

The Municipal Governance and Sustainable Development Programme (MGSDP) was launched in April 2004 to promote democratic governance and improve the quality of life in urban Ukraine.


The Programme's main purpose is to develop the political participation of local communities and municipalities in decision making processes, and by weaving this capacity into public-private partnerships and multi-sectoral interventions geared towards strengthening urban/social/economic/ environmental governance, ultimately leading to more sustainable developments. It will also support the integration of community-based development approach into the local/national policy/legal framework based on experience from Ukrainian cities. For this purpose, the Programme applies social mobilisation tools and facilitates the decentralisation process.

National Partners

UNDP/MGSDP co-operates with city councils; the Parliamentary Committee on State Construction and Local Self-Governance; the Ministry of Regional Development, Construction and Housing and Municipal Economy of Ukraine; and with Ukrainian universities.

COMMUNITY LEVEL

Developing the capacity of local communities to solve local development problems



The MGSDP provides support and training to active community organisations in Ukrainian municipalities. These include Associations of Co-Owners of Multi-Apartment Houses (ACMHs), service co-operatives, civil society organisations of schools and kindergartens and their networks. Such self-sustained organisations are based on the principles of democratic governance and they co-operate with the city councils to develop joint visions of sustainable development.

Community level benefits

- Developing the capacities of local communities allows for the implementation of sustainable development measures in partnership with local authorities. Training is given about establishing community organisations, selecting the appropriate legal forms for organisations and arranging their effective operations. Training and consultations are conducted on local situation assessments, the preparation of project proposals, the selection of contractors, monitoring, public audit and reporting.
- The implementation of local community priorities/projects is supported through seed grants based on principles of equality, transparency and sustainability on a cost-sharing basis. These projects are developed for improving the quality of life.
- The Programme raises awareness at the local community level about sustainable development, HIV/AIDs, the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs), gender equality, human and consumer rights, energy-efficiency, public audit through organising round tables, training and mass media campaigns, amongst others.



MUNICIPAL LEVEL

Raising the bar for local self-governance



The Programme develops the institutional potential of City Councils through providing advisory services, training, visits, study tours and equipment. It raises their capacity for improving local governance, for providing better services as well as for improving the quality of life in municipalities. By involving a wide network of stakeholders in the local development process, the programme supports initiatives on strategic planning; introduces municipal services quality management systems according to the international standard 'ISO'; provides for the holding of public hearings; and integrates community plans into local development plans.

- Co-operation between 23 municipalities and 5 settlements of a municipal type for introduction of community-based local development approach, establishes effective dialogue and cooperation of local authorities and communities for joint solving of local social and economic problems.
- Establishes Municipal Support Units for community initiatives and develops their personnel through training, educational/ networking trips as well as through consultations.
- Provides technical assistance to the Municipal Support Units and helps maintain the official web-sites of the partner city councils created under the Programme support.
- Supports the development of municipal strategic plans





- Facilitates the integration of community organisation plans into municipal development plans.
- Support the introduction of municipal services quality management systems in accordance with the ISO 9001:2008 in Ukrainian municipalities. Study tours give municipal servants the opportunity to learn from the successful introduction of community-based approach of other. East-West exchange visits increase experience and knowledge of local self-governance.
- Information and communication technologies support the establishment of modern, interactive web-sites for more effective communications from local authorities and communities.
- Support to inter-municipal cooperation for exchange of experience. Facilitates e-governance development in Ukraine.
- Improves the solid waste management system in the country.
- Facilitates the dissemination of energy-efficiency technologies in municipalities.



NATIONAL LEVEL

Activities in policy and legislation



Lessons learned at the local level, particularly in the areas of decentralisation and local self-governance, are raised for policy dialogue through policy research, seminars, conferences, round tables etc. These result in:

- Co-operation with the Parliamentary Committee on State Construction and Local Self-Governance, the Ministry of Regional Development, Construction and Housing and Municipal Economy of Ukraine for facilitating reform of housing and municipal economy and decentralisation in Ukraine.
- Analytic research of the state of local self-governance, and the involvement of communities in the decision making process at local levels.
- Generating and disseminating the 'lessons learned' throughout Ukraine.
- Recommendations for Government on improving the quality of public services.
- Training central and local government officials through various courses, such as the 'Decentralization and Effective Local Self-Governance', which looks at the approaches for community participation in decision making processes, and the elaboration of local strategies for sustainable growth.
- The preparation of future generations for dealing with community-based development approach, as well as global problems of humanity and sustainable development. One way is through the educational course 'Sustainable Development of Society' taught at Ukrainian universities.
